This is to advise you of the conclusion of an administrative inquiry regarding an allegation that you made an unauthorized disclosure of classified information to an Assistant United States Attorney, Northern District of Illinois, in violation of a July 19, 1995, Attorney General's Order.

I have reviewed the results of this inquiry and determined that the preponderance of the evidence does not establish that you committed the alleged misconduct. Accordingly, this inquiry is considered closed.

In that respect, an objective and equitable administrative inquiry process benefits all FBI employees by safeguarding the Bureau's integrity and high standards.
