Reference is made to the letter from your attorney, Mr. Richard L. Swick, dated June 20, 2003, appealing your dismissal.

After examining the record in this matter, the Disciplinary Review Board (DRB) has decided to reinstate you to the rolls of the FBI, based on a finding that there was not preponderant evidence supporting the allegations that you were involved with the staged burglary of your home, false police report, and false insurance claim in 1989. The DRB concluded that the uncorroborated statements of your ex-wife and the failed polygraph examination, considering your past history with that test, were not enough to substantiate her allegations against you. Accordingly, you are to be reinstated upon receipt of this letter.

A representative from the Bureau will contact you to coordinate the respective reinstatement procedures.

This is the agency's final decision regarding this matter.
