FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Date of transcription 7/7/93

On July 7, 1993, at approximately 9:15 am, Special Agent (SA) [REDACTED] left the Jefferson City office of the FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION (FBI), which is located at 305 East McCarty. As SA [REDACTED] exited the building and began walking to his parked vehicle in the basement garage, he observed an older model four door Ford, off white or cream colored, with a tan or light brown vinyl top, make a left hand turn from Monroe Street, and enter the garage. This vehicle pulled past SA [REDACTED] vehicle and stopped in the aisle. SA [REDACTED] entered his vehicle and began backing out of the parking space. A white female was observed walking around the back of the Ford vehicle, and then toward the front of the vehicle. As SA [REDACTED] continued to back out, the female appeared to be taking photographs of the vehicles parked on the north side of the garage. SA [REDACTED] recognized this individual as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was asked, "Can I help you?", and she replied, "No. I'm just taking pictures." She then took a picture of the vehicles parked on the south side of the garage, near the garage exit. She entered her vehicle, which was blocking the aisle, and drove out of garage and made a left hand turn onto East McCarty. The vehicle was noted to be bearing Missouri license plate [REDACTED]. It was also noted that she was using a small, red colored camera with a flash. It is believed that she took three to four pictures.

It was determined that Missouri license [REDACTED] is registered to [REDACTED], Regency Mobile Home, Holt's Summitt, Missouri, on a 1980 Ford, four door.
