Synopsis: Summary of telcall between SA (P) [REDACTED]
Dallas, and SA (P) [REDACTED] Chicago, 05/26/1999, re SA
Gamal Abdel-Hafiz, Dallas.

Details: As directed by SSA (P) [REDACTED] Dallas, the
following is a summary of the above-referenced conversation.

On 05/26/1999, SA (P) [REDACTED] telephonically contacted SA
(P) [REDACTED] re a possible Dallas Division criminal investigation of
(G) (P) [REDACTED] is
the subject of Chicago Division case number 265C-CG-101942-Sub
H1-J. It was discussed how Dallas would get access to records
that were part of Chicago's investigation in order for Dallas to
potentially investigate possible violations of U.S. law by
individuals within Dallas' territory who are associated with
HAMAS.

After this discussion, SA (P) [REDACTED] asked SA (P) [REDACTED] if SA
(P) [REDACTED] had heard about what SA Abdel-Hafiz had done. To the best
of SA (P) [REDACTED] recollection there was little transition from the
previous topic of conversation to this question. SA (P) [REDACTED]
replied in the negative to the question.

SA (P) [REDACTED] then advised that, recently, SA Abdel-Hafiz had
been contacted by an individual who was a subject of case number
265C-CG-101942, and who thought that he was going to be
subpoenaed to the Grand Jury. The subject wanted a meeting with
SA Abdel-Hafiz. According to SA (P) [REDACTED] SA Abdel-Hafiz then

contacted Det (P) (Dallas, Texas Police Department), North Texas Joint Terrorism Task Force, re Chicago's investigation. SA Abdel-Hafiz also requested to review Det. (P) file re the investigation.

SA (P) continued, stating that he had requested that SA Abdel-Hafiz wear a recording device to the meeting with the subject, and that SA Abdel-Hafiz had refused. SA (P) responded that perhaps SA Abdel-Hafiz had refused because doing so would jeopardize his standing within the Arab community. SA (P) responded that SA Abdel-Hafiz had previously refused to wear a recording device for Washington Field Office in a similar matter.

SA (P) continued, stating that, recently, (A) (S) (A) SA (P) also stated that Muslim agents should not be assigned to International Terrorism matters, but to matters such as Bank Robbery and White Collar Crime. Commenting further on SA Abdel-Hafiz' refusal to wear a recording device, SA (P) stated that Catholic agents would lose their guns and badges if they refused to work Abortion Clinic matters. SA (P) stated that he did not want SA Abdel-Hafiz to have further access to the files in this matter, and that SA (P) was going to request SA Abdel-Hafiz be removed from the Grand Jury 6(e) list in this matter.

SA (P) responded that he only allows access to Grand Jury records on a need-to-know basis. The conversation ended with SA (P) stating that he would forward a copy of an EC, summarizing case number 265C-CG-101942, to SA (P) who agreed to wait until receiving said EC before authoring an EC, recommending the opening of a criminal investigation of (G)
