The following is a transcript of a phone call between Bill O'Rielly and Gamal Abdel-Hafiz which took place on Monday, 10/20/03. (Noteworthy, is that O'Rielly contacted Abdel-Hafiz.)

Bill:

Bill O'Rielly, how are you Sir?

Gamal:

Fine. How are you Sir, Mr. O'Rielly?

Bill:

Thank you for taking my call.

Gamal:

Thank you for calling me.

Bill:

No, it is a pleasure.

Gamal:

Thank you.

Bill: Uhh..., I am sorry that you got the impression..., it was extended to me that we weren't fair with you the first time around. Uhh..., because that is not the way we operate here. I was limited in what I can say because there was no one around to put forth your point of view at that point. So, all we had to do was...uhh..., put on the FBI agent in Chicago and...Schippers who was, you know, supporting him.

Gamal:

Yes Sir.

Bill: And I understand that only one side was... was put forth, that is why we would... would love to have you to put forth your side. And since I wasn't there, and I don't know what happened, I can assure you, you will get a full hearing and let everybody in the United States of America "unintelligible"

Garnal: I appreciate the offer there, Mr. O'Rielly.... I am really hurt because i.. I admired you for years, before you even went on Fox. As... since The Inside Edition. And I was shocked because what you did to me. You destroyed me and my family.

Bill: Well, let's... let's try to rectify that. Uhh.. you can bring on your lawyer or whoever you wanna bring on with you...

Gamal:

I don't... I don't...

Bill:

And let's put forth your point of view.

Gamal:

I don't need to bring a lawyer.

Bill:

Ok, so let it just be you and me.

Gamal:

Yeah, I come... and I come with everything in my history with the Bureau to

support me.

Bill:

Absolutely.

Gamal:

Uhhh...

Bill: We can... I, look, I wanna hear your point of view and I think America do as well.

This is unfair. You have been tainted ... uhh... somebody who has ... who has devoted a good
